## BROOKLINE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH ADVISORY

August 20, 2021

The Brookline Department of Public Health has been pleased with the level of compliance and cooperation from all local businesses and the Town during this COVID-19. In order to better address Health and Safety concerns the Commissioner of Public Health issues the following notice:

### For the General Public

***Effective August 27, 2021 at 8 a.m. every individual is required to wear a protective face covering at all times indoors including business, private clubs, condos, restaurants, bars, clubs, place of assembly, municipal buildings or other locations open to the public. Individuals with medical conditions prohibiting face covering usage must wear Face Shields. This advisory applies to ages 2+.***

All businesses must conduct following:

- All establishment staff must wear protective face covering and gloves if serving food during service in the establishment.
- All entry doors must be posted – advising customers that face covering is mandated.
- Establishments must increase employee illness surveillance.
